

Rim Country Bicycle Shuttle – Customer Information Sheet

Welcome to Rim Country Bicycles!

We provide safe and reliable shuttle service for mountain bikers and hikers along the scenic **Highline Trail**. Please review the information below before your trip.

Group Information

- Maximum Group Size: 4 people per shuttle
- Minimum Group Size: 1 person
- Reservations: Required in advance (preferably 24+ hours ahead)
- Gear: Bring everything you need to enjoy the ride. All bikes must be in working order; hikers should bring appropriate gear and water.

Pickup locations: Payson – Pine – Strawberry

1. Point-to-Point Trailhead Shuttle

- **Service:** Transport riders, bikes, and gear to Highline Trail trailheads.
- **Ideal For:** Solo riders, groups, and bike packers doing one-way rides.
- **How It Works:**
 - Riders will park at the trailhead where they will finish their ride.

- Rim Country Bicycle picks them up at their vehicle and shuttles them and their bikes and gear to the trailhead from which they start.
- **Pricing:** \$75 for one client, each additional rider is \$50.

Ride at your own pace and enjoy the day knowing your vehicle is waiting for you.

2. Round-Trip Shuttle Service

- **Service:** Transport riders, bikes, and gear to the starting trailhead. Pick riders up at the end-of-ride trailhead and shuttle them back to the point of origin.
- **Ideal for:** Riders and bike packers who are unable to transport their bikes and gear themselves.
- **How it Works:**
 - Rim Country Bicycles picks up riders and their gear at a pre-approved location in or around Payson, Az. And shuttles them to the trailhead they wish to start from.
 - Rim Country Bicycles picks riders up at the ending trailhead and shuttles them back to the pickup point.
 - Note: For this service, Rim Country Bicycles requires riders to download the app "Life360" so employees can monitor pace and communicate about alternate exits if conditions become unfavorable.
- **Pricing:** \$150 for one, each additional rider \$50.

All you have to do is ride.

㊂ 3. Weekend Shuttle Runs on Pine-Strawberry Trail

- **Service:** Shuttle service from Pine to the Pine-Strawberry Trailhead.
- **Ideal For:** Casual riders and weekend warriors.
- **How It Works:** Riders park their vehicle at the pickup spot. (*Note: letter from PNFRG about letting us use the space and how we are donating \$2 per rider to their cause*) RCB shuttles them and their gear to the trailhead, from where they ride back to their vehicle.
- **Pricing:** \$20 per person. (Multiple runs allowed)

Assumption of Risk

I understand that Rim Country Bicycles, the U.S Forest Service, and the Pine Strawberry Fuel Reduction Group, its owners, employees, agents, volunteers, and contractors are **not responsible for loss, damage, or injury** resulting from my participation in the shuttle service or related activities. I voluntarily assume all risks associated with transportation, loading and unloading bicycles and gear, and participation in outdoor recreation.

Release of Liability

In consideration for being allowed to use Rim Country Bicycles' shuttle services, I hereby release, waive, discharge, and agree to hold harmless **Rim Country Bicycles**, its owners, employees, agents, and contractors from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, or causes of action arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury (including death) that may be sustained by me or to any property belonging to me, whether caused by negligence or otherwise.

Transportation of Bikes and Gear

I acknowledge that while Rim Country Bicycles takes reasonable precautions to safely transport bicycles and gear, **the Company assumes no responsibility for damage or loss** to bicycles, equipment, or personal property during loading, unloading, or transit. It is my responsibility to ensure my bicycle and gear are properly secured prior to transportation.

Medical Treatment

I understand that in the event of an accident or injury, Rim Country Bicycles personnel may obtain medical assistance on my behalf if deemed necessary, and I agree to be responsible for any resulting costs.

Rules and Conduct

I agree to follow all instructions provided by Rim Country Bicycles staff and to conduct myself in a safe and responsible manner. I understand that failure to do so may result in refusal of service without refund.

Binding Effect

This release is binding upon my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns. If any portion of this document is held invalid, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect.
